NATIVE PERENNIAL Big Bluestem Grass Andropogon gerardi

Sun: full sun

Water: average; drought tolerant once established Maintenance: divide every 2-3 years

- Height: 4-7'; Width: 2-3'
- Family: Poaceae; Zones 4-9
- Produces foliage in late spring; Forms 3" bronze to purple or green seed heads, tall & slender stems are blue-green in summer
- Deep roots wind tolerance
- Uses: Conservation, erosion control, wildflower meadows, prairie plantings, border, accents, wildlife shelter, & livestock grass
