## PERENNIAL Karl Foerster (Feather reed) *Calamagrostis acutiflora*



Sun: Full to Partial Water: average; drought tolerant once established Maintenance: divide every 2-3 years; cut previous year's growth in late winter or early spring

- Height: 3-5'; Width: 1.5-2.5'
- Family: Poaceae; Zone 4-10
- Deep green, lustrous foliage from early spring to winter; forms erect clumps with feathery plumes.
- Tolerates: wet soil, air pollution, black walnuts
- Does well in heavy clay soils (unlike other ornamental grasses)
- Uses: cut flowers, dried flowers, erosion control, rain garden
