



NATIVE PERENNIAL

Winecup, Purple Poppy Mallow *Callirhoe involucrata*

Sun: Full Sun to Part Shade

Water: average; drought tolerant

Maintenance: divide every 2-3 years; cut previous year's growth in late winter or early spring

- Height: 3'
- Family: Malvaceae; Zone
- Magenta blooms; June - July
- Rosy-purple; blooms all summer; saucer shaped flowers
- Uses: edge of flowerbed; bedding plant; hanging basket; hanging on rock wall or over a bank
